

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 294957

ADOPTED ON JUN 05 2001

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego Police Department desires to apply for and, if selected, to accept and expend a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) called "Citizen Volunteers Reduce Pedestrian Fatalities," the purpose of which is to train and deploy citizen volunteers to provide pedestrian safety education, and to identify and correct road conditions hazardous to pedestrians, as described in the grant application proposal, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 294957; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Chief of Police be, and is hereby, authorized and empowered, for and on behalf of the City of San Diego, to accept and administer funds for this program, and that such authorization shall include all aspects of grant acceptance, operation, expenditures, and certification that the City will comply with all applicable statutory or regulatory requirements related to said program;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the Chief of Police to execute any amendments, extensions, renewals, or future funding for this program for a period of up to five years, provided funding is made available by the State of California;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any liability arising out of our performance of this Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the City of San Diego. The State of California and the California Office of Traffic Safety disclaim responsibility for any such liability;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City is authorized to provide the required matching resources, and ongoing costs of operation relating to this program, including any amendments thereof, under the program and funding terms and conditions of the State of California and the Office of Traffic Safety;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds and/or resources received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body, and that personnel positions funded hereunder are not subject to local hiring freezes.
