WHEREAS, Ronald A. Reina has spent more than twenty-five years in broadcasting, both as a radio and television sportscaster working at numerous San Diego stations including KDEO, KFMB Radio/TV and KSDO; and

WHEREAS, he was known for seventeen years as the "Voice of the Aztecs" while performing play-by-play duties for games of San Diego State University; and

WHEREAS, Ron Reina served on the Board of Directors of the local chapter of the March of Dimes and Inroads San Diego; and

WHEREAS, in 1995 he was appointed Special Assistant to the Sheriff and Public Affairs Officer, in charge of all media relations for Sheriff Kolender and for the entire department, as well as for all publications and video operations; and

WHEREAS, Ron Reina has handled high-profile cases that attracted worldwide attention including the Heaven's Gate mass suicide and the Santana High School shooting, and due to his efforts, the Sheriff's Department received kudos for their handling of these cases; and

WHEREAS, he also served as the department liaison to the Honorary Deputy Sheriff's Association, the Law Enforcement Foundation and the Crime Stoppers Organization as well as serving on numerous department committees; and

WHEREAS, Ron Reina recently retired after six years of dedicated service to the San Diego County Sheriff's Department and to the citizens of our City and County; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby recognize the many accomplishments and dedication of Ron Reina, and hereby proclaims July 23, 2001 to be "**Ronald A. Reina Day**" in the City of San Diego.
