 - (b) the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land; and
- (c) the vacation is not inconsistent with the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; and
- (d) the public street system for which the right-of-way was originally acquired will not be detrimentally affected by this vacation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the street vacation easement, reserving out a general utility and access easement, as more particularly described in the legal description marked as Exhibit "A", and shown on Drawing No. 19382-B marked as Exhibit "B", attached hereto and made a part hereof, is ordered

vacated.

2. That the City Clerk shall cause a certified copy of this resolution, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.
