

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 295322

WHEREAS, historic records indicate that a burn dump was operated prior to 1938 in the vicinity of 38th and Redwood Streets; and

WHEREAS, the City is in the process of accepting a matching grant from the California Integrated Waste Management Board in connection with the 38th and Redwood Burn Site project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council by Resolution No. R-294625, adopted on March 5, 2001, certified Negative Declaration, LDR File No. 40-0912, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk; and


WHEREAS, in connection with the consideration of accepting a matching grant for the 38th and Redwood Burn Site project the City Council considered the issues discussed in Negative Declaration, LDR File No. 40-0912; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the information contained in the final document, including any comments received during the public review process, has been reviewed and considered by this Council and it is determined that no substantial changes or new information of substantial importance within the meaning of CEQA Guideline section 15162 would warrant any additional environmental review in connection with approval of accepting a matching grant from California Integrated Waste Management Board for the 38th and Redwood Burn Site project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of Determination [NOD] with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego regarding the above project.
