WHEREAS, a bill is currently pending before the Legislature in Sacramento, State Senate Bill 187 [SB 187], which would require the State Department of Health Services to establish and maintain a voluntary medical marijuana qualified patient registry and identification system; and

WHEREAS on August 8, 2001, the Public Safety & Neighborhood Services Committee of the City Council voted to recommend that the City support SB 187; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City supports the passage of SB 187 into law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby directed to communicate the City's support for SB 187 to the appropriate representatives in Sacramento.
