RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN
DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND
EXPENDITURE OF A DEFENSE RETENTION SUPPORT
GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA TECHNOLOGY, TRADE
AND COMMERCE AGENCY

WHEREAS, the uniformed military services are the largest single component of the San Diego economy; and

WHEREAS, beginning in 1993, the federal government has implemented a number of military base closures under the Base Realignment and Closure law (BRAC); and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has been impacted by closure of the Naval Training Center, and will continue to be impacted in the future by the continuing BRAC process; and

WHEREAS, the California Technology, Trade and Commerce Agency offers an annual grant to local jurisdictions for assistance with base and defense industry retention and partnerships between military facilities and public entities; NOW THEREFORE;

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Manager is authorized to submit to the California Technology, Trade, and Commerce Agency an application for a Defense Retention Grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is authorized to execute all agreements with the California Technology, Trade and Commerce Agency which are necessary to accept the grant, as well as any and all documents necessary to carry out the purpose of the grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall remain in full force and effect until a resolution of the Council is adopted which amends or rescinds this resolution.
