- 3. That the City Manager, or designee, is authorized to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.

- 4. That the City Manager, or designee, is authorized to accept monies set forth under the Cooperative Agreement.
- 5. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to place all funds received pursuant to the Cooperative Agreement into the City's Habitat Acquisition Fund (#10571) for the purposes of acquiring open space.
