WHEREAS, San Diego Foundation for Change will host its annual Change Maker Celebration on November 9, 2001; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Foundation for Change's mission is to seek positive, permanent change to end discrimination, lack of opportunity, poverty and environmental degradation in San Diego County and the U.S.- Mexico border region while promoting equity, economic renewal and environmental health for all; and

WHEREAS, this year San Diego Foundation for Change awarded 25 diverse groups a total of \$62,000, and since 1983, has awarded more than \$480,000 in seed grants to area organizations; and
