WHEREAS, the annual election was conducted on October 2, 2001, after notice and according to the Project PAC bylaws and procedures enumerated within the documents approved by the Council; and

WHEREAS, a representative from the City Clerk's office attended the October 2, 2001, election to ensure its validity; and

WHEREAS, the elected members of the PAC have submitted to the Council information establishing the qualifications of each person relative to district, category or organization as appropriate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the College Community Redevelopment Project Area Committee consisting of persons named on the list of PAC members receiving the highest number of votes attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by this reference is approved as constituting a representative PAC.
- 2. That the Council concurs that the election results of October 2, 2001, are valid and binding in accordance with the procedures so adopted by Resolution No. R-280718.
- 3. That the Project PAC be extended for a period of one year from the date of this resolution.
