WHEREAS, at a duly noticed public hearing to be conducted by the Council of the City of San Diego on June 16, 1998 the City Council considered and took action to select an alignment for State Route 56; and


WHEREAS, the City Council by Resolution No. R-290286, adopted on June 16, 1998, certified Environmental Impact Report, LDR File No. 95-0099 dated May 14, 1998 [EIR], a copy of which is on file in the Development Services Department; and

WHEREAS, in connection with considering whether to enter into a Cooperative Agreement with the Pardee Construction Company concerning funding from the Camino Santa Fe/Route 56 Interchange the City Council considered the issues discussed in EIR; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the information contained in the final document, including any comments received during the public review process, has been reviewed and considered by this Council and it is determined that no substantial changes or new information of substantial importance within the meaning of CEQA Guideline section 15162 would warrant any additional environmental review in connection with approval of Camino Santa Fe/State Route 56 Interchange.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of Determination [NOD] with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego regarding the above project.
