WHEREAS, the UCSD women's soccer team defeated Christian Brothers University women's soccer team, 2-0, before a Triton Soccer Stadium crowd of 1,645; and

WHEREAS, the UCSD women's soccer team has won seven National Collegiate Athletic Association championships since the program's inception; and

WHEREAS, the UCSD women's soccer team has produced doctors, attorneys, engineers, local teachers, and business and community leaders; and

WHEREAS, the UCSD women's soccer team continuously involve themselves in community service, and are highly visible in the academic campus community as tutors, department interns and student advisory board members; and

WHEREAS, the sport of soccer, both for competition and recreation, has grown to become a major part of the community by its ability to bring cultural and gender diversity to the myriad of venues at which it is played throughout our community; NOW, THEREFORE,
