

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 19021 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON JAN 0 8 2002

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 1, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 22.0101 RELATING TO PERMANENT RULES OF THE COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, section 22.0101 of the San Diego Municipal Code, as amended, establishes permanent rules of procedure governing the operation of the Council; and

WHEREAS, in order to make Council meetings more efficient, section 22.0101 would need to be amended to give greater flexibility in scheduling evening Council meetings by allowing the Council to hold evening meetings to “at least four times” per year instead of “quarterly; and

WHEREAS, since consent items are heard only on Mondays, this amendment would allow consent items to be heard on either Monday or Tuesday; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 2 Article 2, Division 1, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by amending section 22.0101, to read as follows:

§22.0101 Permanent Rules of the Council

Rule 1 . Hours of Meeting

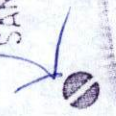
(a) through (c) - No change in text.

(d) Regular Council meetings shall be held in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, Community Concourse, in the City of San Diego, California. In addition thereto, the Council shall also hold regularly scheduled night Council meetings in various community facilities

Administration Building. Such night Council meetings will be scheduled at least four times during each twelve-month period, with the specific date, time and location of each meeting to be established by resolution of the Council. In the event a regular meeting shall fall on a legal holiday, the Meeting may be held on the next business day.

(e) through (g) - No change in text.

Rule 2. Parliamentary Procedure. - No change in text.

Rule 3. Procedure for Council Meetings

The order of business for Council meetings shall be as follows:

Monday at 2:00 p.m. - No change in numbers 1 through 9.

Tuesday at 9:00 a.m.

1. Roll Call
2. Non-agenda Public Comment (limited to three (3) minutes—See Rule 8)
3. Requests for Continuance
4. Adoption Agenda
 - (a) Consent Items
 - (b) Noticed Hearings (to be scheduled at various times throughout the day by the City Clerk based on the number of hearings and reasonable expectation of length) and Special Hearings
 - (c) Unfinished Business from Monday
5. Non-agenda items under Rule 30
6. Adjournment

Rule 4 through Rule 34 - No change in text.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its final passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 1, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 22.0101 RELATING TO PERMANENT RULES OF THE COUNCIL.

This ordinance amends the San Diego Municipal Code to change the Permanent Rules of Council by scheduling at least four evening Council meetings, and adding Tuesday consent items.

This ordinance contains a notice that a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final passage, since a written or printed copy will be available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its final passage.

This ordinance shall take effective force immediately upon its passage after two (2) public hearings pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.


