BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that pursuant to authority conferred by and in accordance with the provisions of Section 86.04 of the San Diego Municipal Code, two PARKING TIME LIMIT OF TWO HOURS, effective between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., Sundays and certain holidays excepted, be and the same is hereby established on the west side of Columbia Street, between Date and Fir Street, and on the east side of Columbia Street, between Fir Street and a point of 165 feet, south of Fir Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the provisions of Council Policy 2004-04 that requires 75% curb occupancy in order to establish time limit parking is hereby waived.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the installation of the necessary signs and markings be and the same are hereby authorized to be made on said streets, and the regulations herein above imposed shall become effective upon the installation of such signs.
