WHEREAS, an improvement project for the Torrey Pines South Course was made possible through a model public/private partnership between the City of San Diego, civic and community leaders who are a part of the Torrey Pines Founders Circle that contributed more than \$3 million to pay for the restoration of Torrey Pines under the direction of world famous golf course architect Rees Jones; and

WHEREAS, this South Course renovation project included, along with the new design, a rebuilding of 18 greens, one practice green, and an additional 25 sand bunkers to bring the total number of bunkers to 77, and the new greens now average 6,000 square feet as opposed to the previous green size of 5,000 square feet; and

WHEREAS, San Diegans will gather to celebrate the re-opening of the newly renovated Torrey Pines South Course with a ribbon cutting ceremony on February 5, 2002; and

WHEREAS, as part of the ribbon cutting ceremony, San Diego professional golfers will take part in a "driving-in ceremony" teeing off in unison down the first fairway; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Park and Recreation Department and the Torrey Pines Founders Circle are hereby commended for their commitment to offer quality places for recreational opportunities.
