

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 295964

ADOPTED ON JAN 22 2002

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the plans and specifications for the furnishing of all labor, material, tools, equipment, transportation and other expense necessary or incidental for the Construction of Water Group Job 501, filed in the office of the City Clerk of the City of San Diego, California, on JAN 22 2002, and bearing official Document No. W.D. 181501, as advertised by the Contract Services Division of the City of San Diego, be and the same are hereby approved.
2. That the Contract Services Division is authorized and directed to proceed to publish notice to contractors calling for bids for the Project, in accordance with the plans and specifications referred to in Paragraph 1.
3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish contract funding phases and to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the Project, provided that the City Auditor and Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure under established contract funding phases are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
4. That the use of City Forces for making temporary cuts and plugs, making live connections of the water main, and installing valves and crosses in an amount not to exceed \$494,429 from Water Fund 41500, CIP No. 73-083.0, is hereby authorized.
5. That the expenditure, not to exceed \$2,689,104 from Water Fund 41500, CIP

No. 73-083.0, Annual Allocation - Water Main Replacement, is hereby authorized solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for the Project and related costs, provided that the City Auditor and Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates demonstrating that the funds necessary for expenditure under established contract funding phases are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

6. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized, upon advice from the administering department, to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.
