

RESOLUTION NUMBER R - 295974

ADOPTED ON JAN 22 2002

WHEREAS, the third annual San Diego's "6 to 6" Annual Report has been prepared and submitted for City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has developed a strategic plan for soliciting private donations and corporate sponsorships, which would be facilitated by the establishment of a San Diego's "6 to 6" Trust Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City and San Diego Unified School District have been granted \$1,600,000, annually, in Federal "21st" Century Community Learning Centers Program" funds, which is a three year grant for FY 2002, FY 2003, and FY 2004; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified School District, as fiscal agent of the grant, has agreed to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the City of San Diego to pass through \$905,000, annually, to expand enrollment at ten "6 to 6" sites; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Council accept and approve the San Diego's "6 to 6" Annual Report.
2. That the City Manager is authorized to establish a San Diego's "6 to 6" Trust Fund.
3. That the City Manager is authorized to accept, and the Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to appropriate and expend grant funds from the Federal Department of Education in

FY 2002 - FY 2004 in an amount not to exceed \$950,000 per fiscal year, provided that Auditor's Certificates are issued demonstrating that funds for such obligations are or will be deposited in the City Treasury.

4. That the City Manager is authorized to negotiate and enter into agreements with contractors to expand "6 to 6" programs at ten selected sites, for an amount not to exceed \$825,000 annually.
