WHEREAS, he had a distinguished professional career with the San Diego Police Department, rising to Captain in 1995, and serving in various areas of the City in the Traffic Division, Mid-City Vice Unit, Canine Unit/Special Enforcement, Field Operations, In-Service Training, and Internal Affairs; and

WHEREAS, former Captain Resch was awarded the Commanding Officer's Citation five times for his alertness, attention to duty, teamwork, investigative ability, leadership, dedication, and professionalism; and

WHEREAS, he continually shared his skills and expertise by serving as Acting Captain of the Training and Development Division, by participating in the Counterintelligence Training Exercise with the U.S. Marine Corps, by serving as the Acting Captain of the Special Enforcement Division; by chairing a committee that developed a curriculum to train new detectives and supervisors, and by his exceptional efforts to develop the Economic and Crime Summit at the Wilson Academy for which he received a Supervisor's Commendation; and

WHEREAS, he received his second Supervisor's Commendation for Acting Captain of the Eastern Division where he implemented several programs that have had a significant impact on maintaining a high level of morale at the Division; and

WHEREAS, he most recently received Employee of the Month, Traffic Division, in 1999, and the Subordinate Officer 's Commendation in 2001; and

WHEREAS, Cliff Resch effectively, courageously, and valiantly gave of himself to protect the citizens of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that February 25, 2002, is hereby proclaimed to be "**Cliff Resch Day**" in San Diego in recognition of his exemplary years of service to the residents of the City of San Diego and to the San Diego Police Department.
