BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the City Manager is authorized to enter into a Cooperative Agreement with the Pardee Construction Company, for the design and construction of the State Route 56 / Camino Santa Fe Interchange, as more particularly described in the Cooperative Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 296120; contingent upon the Auditor and Comptroller first certifying that funds are available in the City Treasury.
- 2. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to modify the FY 2002 Capital Improvement Program by increasing \$9,900,000 to CIP No. 52-463.0 (SR-56/Camino Santa Fe Interchange), Fund 63022.
- 3. That the acceptance of \$9,900,000 from the Pardee Construction Company and depositing said amount in Fund 63022, CIP No. 52-463.0 is hereby authorized.
- 4. That the appropriation and expenditure of \$9,900,000 from CIP No. 52-463.0 (SR-56/Camino Santa Fe Interchange), Fund 63022 to the State of California for the purpose of designing and constructing the State Route 56/Camino Santa Fe Interchange, is hereby authorized, contingent upon the Auditor and Comptroller first certifying that funds are available in the City Treasury.
- 5. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into two agreements with the California Department of Transportation for the funding, design, and construction on the SR-56/Camino Santa Fe Interchange.
- 6. Stating for the record that the final Environmental Impact Report has been reviewed and considered prior to approving the project, and that the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of Determination [NOD] with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego regarding this project.
- 7. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Facilities Benefit Assessment Credit and Reimbursement Agreement for costs associated with the SR-56 Camino Santa Fe Interchange which includes reimbursement of \$9,900,000 plus interest in an amount not to

exceed \$1,782,000, contingent upon the Auditor and Comptroller first certifying that funds are available in the City Treasury.
