WHEREAS, the City of San Diego and Western Pacific Housing, Inc., Len-Greystone Homes, Inc., Len-Greystone Torrey Highland, LLC, and D.R. Horton San Diego Holding Co., Inc., and MicMillan Companies, LLC approved the First Amendment to the Funding Agreement extending the State Route 56 Phase 1 Project, westerly to the State Route 56/Camino Ruiz Interchange [Project]; and

WHEREAS, the matter was set for a public hearing to be conducted by the Council of the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the matter was heard by the City Council on APR 02 2002; and

WHEREAS, the City Council by Resolution No. R-290286, adopted on June 16, 1998, certified Environmental Impact Report, LDR File No. 95-0099, a copy of which is on file in the Development Services Department; and



section 15162 would warrant any additional environmental review in connection with approval of the First Amendment to the Funding Agreement of the Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of Determination [NOD] with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego regarding the above project.
