WHEREAS, the partnership between the City of San Diego and Harmonium that has improved the quality of life of hundreds of thousands of San Diego residents since 1975; and

WHEREAS, with innovation and excellence as guiding values and a belief that "prevention is the best intervention," Harmonium strengthens communities one family at a time; and
