

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 296333

ADOPTED ON APR 15 2002

WHEREAS, at the beginning of his term, Mayor Dick Murphy set ten goals for the City to achieve in order for San Diego to be “a city worthy of our affection” in the Year 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Blue Ribbon Committee on City Finances consists of talented professionals in our community; and

WHEREAS, Joe Craver, Mary Ball, April Boling, William McCurine, Jr., Andrew Poat, April Riel, Victor A. Vilaplana, Richard H. Vortmann and Linc Ward were selected by the

Mayor to serve on the Committee; and

WHEREAS, Linc Ward, former Vice President/General Manager of Pacific Bell in San Diego, is a member of the City Council Select Committee on Government Operations and Fiscal Reform; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby commend **LINC WARD** for his outstanding contributions to our community and for his dedicated service to the Blue Ribbon Committee on City Finances.
