SUGGESTION: Mr. Leber was a Lifeguard I at the time of submittal. His suggestion was to replace rescue paddle boards that have sharp fiber glass fins with plastic fins with soft rubber edge surrounding the fins to prevent injury during use. This suggestion was adopted in December 2000. This amount represents an intangible award and is considered a safety improvement.

NAME(S): Gunnar Granquist  
DEPARTMENT: Fire and Life Safety Services  
AMOUNT: \$25.00  
SUGGESTION: Mr. Granquist was a Lifeguard II at the time of submittal. His suggestion was to install permanent signs advising swimmers about hazardous conditions instead of putting them up in the morning and taking them down at night. This suggestion was adopted in August 2000. This amount represents an intangible award and is considered a safety improvement.
