A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND EXPENDITURE OF STATE GRANT FUNDS FOR DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF PHASE I OF THE STATE ROUTE 252 CORRIDOR PARK; AND AMENDMENT OF THE CIP BUDGET

WHEREAS, the Safe Neighborhood Parks, Clean Water, Clean Air, and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2000 authorized the State of California Department of Parks and Recreation to administer the Murray-Hayden Urban Parks and Youth Service Program to provide grant funds for capital projects, including parks, park facilities, environmental enhancement projects, and youth centers that are within immediate proximity of neighborhoods with a critical lack of parks or deteriorated park facilities, significant poverty and unemployment, and shortages of services for youth, with priority to projects that employ neighborhood residents and at-risk youth;

WHEREAS, the State Route 252 Corridor Park Project- Phase I meets the eligibility criteria for funding under the grant program in that the proposed park is located in a high-density

urban area with a critical shortage of recreational facilities, the Project will develop a park with a playground, picnic areas, walkways, turf, and a restroom, and the Project will include a collaboration with the Urban Corps of San Diego to recruit young adults to work on parts of the project;

WHEREAS, pursuant to an agreement between the City and the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego (City Clerk Doc. No. RR-292980-1, approved by Reso. No. R-292980 adopted April 11, 2000), the Redevelopment Agency is transferring property for the park to the City for the construction and development of a neighborhood park.

WHEREAS, if the grant is secured, the total cost of \$1,110,000 for Phase I of the Project will be funded though use of the grant funds (\$610,000) and City matching funds (\$500,000); NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Council authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to apply to the State of California Department of Parks and Recreation for a grant of \$610,000 under the Murray-Hayden Urban Parks and Youth Service Program for the development of Phase I of the State Route 252 Corridor Park.
- 2. That the Council authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to take all necessary actions to secure and accept grant funding and enter into an agreement for this project.

- 3. That, if the grant funds are secured, the Council appropriates and authorizes the City Auditor and Comptroller to accept and expend funds.
- 4. That, if the grant funds are secured, the Council authorizes the Auditor and Comptroller to establish a special interest-bearing fund for the grant.
- 5. That the Council authorizes the Auditor and Comptroller, upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement, to amend the Fiscal Year 2002 Capital Improvement Program Budget to add \$610,000 to CIP No. 29-458.0, State Route 252 Corridor Park.
- 6. That, if the grant funds are secured, the Council appropriates and authorizes the City Manager or designee to expend \$610,000 from CIP No. 29-458.0, State Route 252 Corridor Park, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the grant funding agreement.
- 7. That the Council certifies that the required matching funds are or will be available prior to commencement of any work on the project.
- 8. That the Council certifies that the City has or will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project.

9. That the Council has reviewed, understands, and agrees to the terms of the grant, as set forth in the General Provisions contained in the Contract shown in the Murray-Hayden Program Procedural Guide.
