

RESOLUTION NUMBER R-296659

ADOPTED ON JUNE 11, 2002

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN
DIEGO ESTABLISHING A ONE YEAR TRIAL OFF-LEASH
AREA FOR DOGS AT DUSTY RHODES NEIGHBORHOOD
PARK.

WHEREAS, on May 30, 1972, the City Council approved by Ordinance No. 10843 the first off-leash areas for dogs in San Diego at Fiesta Island and Dog Beach; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code section 63.0102 authorizes the Park and Recreation Director [Director] to designate dog exercise and training [Off-Leash] areas; in City-owned parks; and

WHEREAS, in 1993, the Director authorized a trial Off-Leash area at Grape Street Park in Balboa Park; on April 12, 1999, City Council approved by Resolution No. R-291472 amended off-leash area boundaries and hours at Grape Street Park; and in 2000, the Director authorized continuing the boundaries and hours of the trial Off-Leash area at Grape Street Park; and

WHEREAS, in 1996, the Director authorized trial Off-Leash areas at Nates Point and Morley Field behind the tennis courts, both in Balboa Park; and in 2001, the Director authorized trial Off-Leash areas at Maddox Neighborhood Park and Cadman Community Park; and

WHEREAS, there continues to be an unmet recreational demand by the public for areas where dogs can legally be off-leash; and

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes that off-leash dog activity to be a valid recreational use; and

WHEREAS, areas authorized to be off-leash areas benefit the residents of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to establish a trial Off-Leash area at Dusty Rhodes Neighborhood Park; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Council hereby establishes, for a period of one year, a trial Off-Leash area for dogs at Dusty Rhodes Neighborhood Park, in Mission Bay Park.
2. That the Off-Leash area is described as approximately 1.00 turfed acre in the northeast area of Dusty Rhodes Neighborhood Park, immediately north of the parking lot located off of Nimitz Boulevard, as indicated in Exhibit A (Map of Dusty Rhodes Neighborhood Park), and will include a perimeter fence.
3. That the Council directs the City Manager, or designee, to implement the Off-Leash area at Dusty Rhodes Neighborhood Park.
4. That the Council authorizes amendment of the Fiscal Year 2002 Capital Improvements Program Budget by adding CIP No. 29-604.0, Dusty Rhodes Neighborhood Park Off Leash Area.
5. That the Council authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to apply to the San Diego Foundation for \$5,350 in Mission Bay Park Endowment Funds for the purpose of constructing an Off-Leash area for dogs at Dusty Rhodes Neighborhood Park.

6. That the Council authorizes amendment of the Fiscal Year 2002 Capital Improvements Budget by increasing CIP No. 29-604.0, Dusty Rhodes Neighborhood Park Off Leash Area, in the amount of \$5,350 from Fund No. 10365, Park and Recreation Matching Funds, from the Mission Bay Park Endowment Fund, contingent upon the San Diego Foundation's approval of the City's funding application, and from Fund No. 10365, Park and Recreation Matching Funds, in the amount of \$5,350, contingent upon City Council appropriation of a sufficient Fiscal Year 2003 Matching Fund Budget for this purpose.

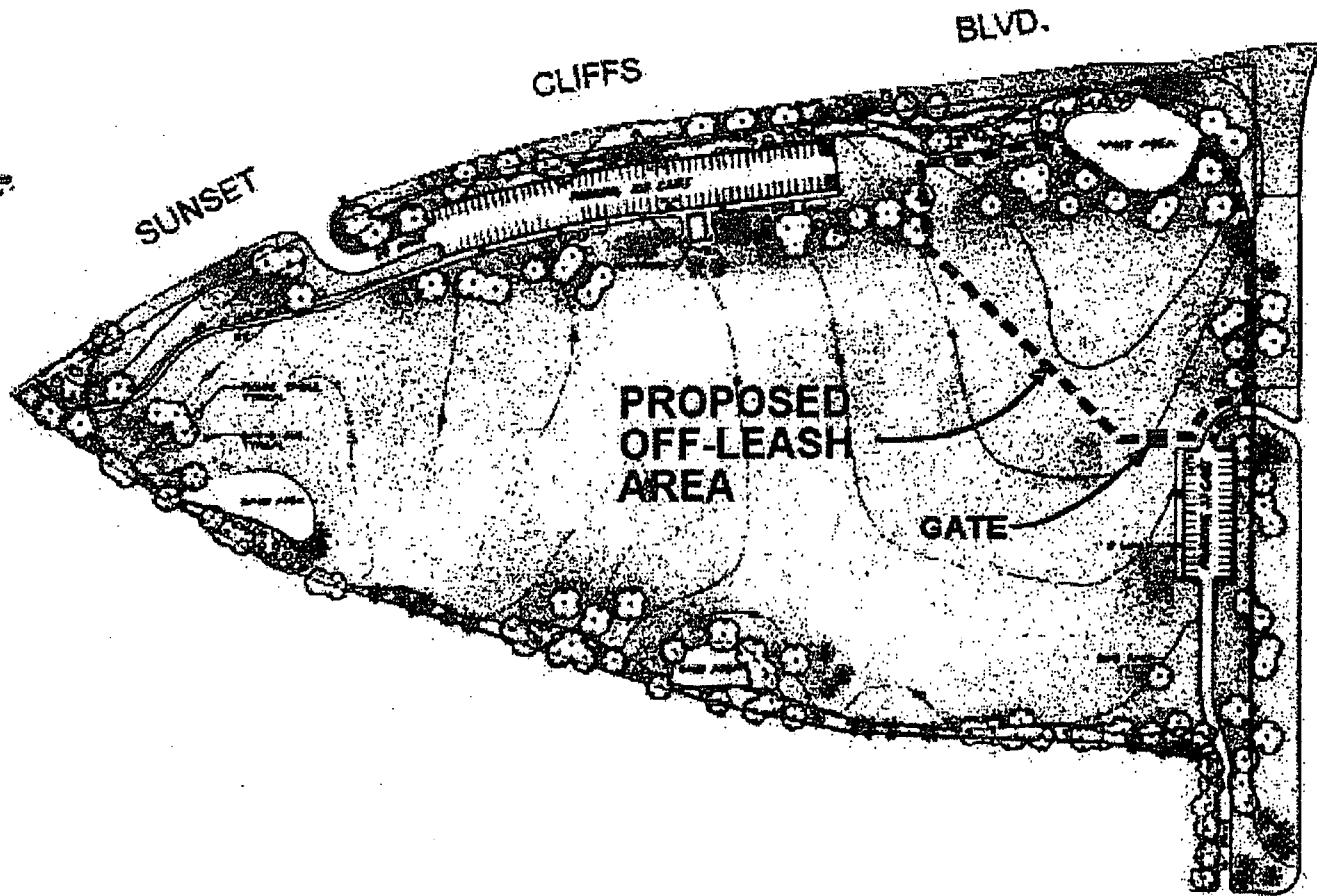
7. That the Council appropriates and authorizes the City Auditor and Comptroller to expend an amount not to exceed \$10,700 from CIP No. 29-604.0, Dusty Rhodes Neighborhood Park Off Leash Area, from Fund No. 10365, Park and Recreation Matching Funds, in the amount of \$5,350, from Mission Bay Park Endowment Fund, contingent upon San Diego Foundation's approval of the City's funding application; and from Fund No. 10365, Park and Recreation Matching Funds, in the amount of \$5,350, contingent upon City Council appropriation of a sufficient Fiscal Year 2003 Matching Fund budget for this purpose.


