WHEREAS, Jacquelyn Littlefield's family has been involved with the Spreckels Theatre for more than 70 years; and

WHEREAS, Jacquelyn Littlefield has owned and operated the Spreckels Building since 1970, significantly restoring its original splendor, and Jacquelyn acquired the Spreckels Building's status as a National Historic Site in 1972; and

WHEREAS, Jacquelyn Littlefield has been a lifelong champion and a stalwart supporter of San Diego's performing arts, providing office space to the San Diego Performing Arts League in its infancy to Mainly Mozart for over twelve years, and to the original Artstix Booth; and

WHEREAS, Jacquelyn has continually endeavored to place the Spreckels Theatre at the forefront of San Diego's performing arts venues, thereby attracting visitors from near and far to San Diego's downtown area; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby proclaim June 12, 2002, to be "**Jacquelyn Littlefield Day**" in the City of San Diego.
