WHEREAS, he planned and built several facilities at the parish including the parish center, the rectory and completion of the church; and

WHEREAS, he has been very involved in helping the missions over the years building peoples awareness of the mission's activities all over the world and right in our backyard across the border; and

WHEREAS, under his leadership, San Rafael has been a leader among San Diego

parishes in raising funds for the missions; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, hereby proclaims Sunday, June 30, 2002, to be "Monsignor Lloyd V. Bourgeois Day" in the City of San Diego.
