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A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE, EXPENDITURE AND ADMINISTRATION OF A CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF HISTORIC PRESERVATION, DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION, SERVING THE SAN DIEGUITO RIVER VALLEY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego adopted the San Dieguito River Regional Plan to direct and guide future development and preservation of the San Dieguito River Valley on October 30, 1984 by Resolution No. 261853; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego submitted a grant request to the California State

Office of Historic Preservation, Department of Parks and Recreation for a San Dieguito River

Valley Archeological Resources Inventory Project; and

WHEREAS, the San Dieguito River Valley Archeological Resources Inventory Project will create an inventory of archaeological resources in the San Dieguito River Valley Planning Area that will consolidate all previously conducted surveys into a single document; and

WHEREAS, in September 2001, the State Office of Historic Preservation Department of Parks and Recreation informed the City of San Diego that it had awarded a Certified Local Government [CLG] Grant in the amount of \$25,000 for a Survey of San Dieguito River Valley Archeological Resources; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

- 1. That the City Manager, and/or designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute all documents, including applications, contracts, agreements, and amendments hereto, necessary to accept, implement and carry out the purposes of the California Certified Local Government Grant.
- 2. That the City Manager, and/or designee, is authorized and empowered, for and on behalf of the City of San Diego, to accept, appropriate, expend and administer the Certified Local Government grant from the State of California, Office of Historic Preservation, Department of Parks and Recreation for the San Dieguito River Valley Archeological Resources Inventory Project to carry out and administer the City's obligations, responsibilities, and duties under the terms of the Grant.
- 3. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is directed to establish a separate interestbearing account for the grant.
