WHEREAS, the Point Loma Presbyterian Church offers more than 500 children and young adults church school, LOGOS, confirmation and Young Life programs to foster spiritual and social connections; and

WHEREAS, over the years, the Point Loma Presbyterian Church has grown with the San Diego community and has provided services like the Chatsworth Adult Center to those in need; and

WHEREAS, the Point Loma Presbyterian Church is fondly referred to as "the Red Brick Church" by the community and serves as a historical reminder of New England architecture; and

WHEREAS, the Music Department of the Point Loma Presbyterian Church provides Christmas Concerts and the Summer Courtyard Concert Series to attract a greater cross section of the San Diego population; and

WHEREAS, the Partners in Prayer ministry seeks to foster a greater sense of community by remembering every member of the congregation by name; and

WHEREAS, the Point Loma Presbyterian Church was chartered by 115 people who gathered at Point Loma High School on June 27, 1937; and

WHEREAS, 2002 marks the 65th Anniversary of the Point Loma Presbyterian Church;
