WHEREAS, Section 10 of the Charter of The City of San Diego provides that commencing with the year 1998 the Municipal Primary Elections to the offices of Councilmember of Districts 2, 4, 6 and 8 shall be held on the same date in each election year as the California State Primary Election, and the General Municipal Election for these offices shall be held on the same date as the California State General Election for that year; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting on _______, the City Council adopted

WHEREAS, it is desirable that this General Municipal Election be consolidated with the California State General Election to be held on the same date and that within The City of San Diego the election precincts, polling places, voting booths, and election officials for the two elections be the same; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego be authorized to canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election; and

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
WHEREAS, it is desirable that this election and the California State General Election be held in all respects as if there were only one election; and

WHEREAS, in the year 2002, the California State General Election will be held on the 5th day of November; and

WHEREAS, this Council within the time required by law has adopted, or will adopt, an ordinance calling for a General Municipal Election; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby requested to consolidate the General Municipal Election for the office of Councilmember for Districts 2 and 4 to be held in the City of San Diego on November 5, 2002, with the California State General Election to be held on the same date.
- 2. That the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election and is requested to conduct the election in all respects as if there were only one election using only one form of ballot.
- 3. That the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is requested to issue to all officers of the County charged with duties pertaining to the California State General Election appropriate instructions to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of a consolidated election.
- 4. That the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby requested to authorize and direct the Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego to perform the following:
 - (a) Furnish a tabulation of the number of registered voters in each Council district by precinct;
