BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Manager is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of the City, an agreement with the County, to develop and implement a countywide pilot Fire and Rescue Helicopter Program, to be operated and managed by the City Fire and Life Safety Services Department and to accept and expend funds from the County in the amount of \$50,000 for the pilot program, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 296841-2.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to transfer an amount not to exceed \$190,000 from General Fund No. 10001 - Allocated Reserve - to the Pilot Helicopter Program Fund 10264, solely and exclusively to provide funds for the pilot Fire and Rescue Helicopter Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Manager is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of the City, an agreement with Eagle Helicopters, Inc., doing business as Kachina Aviation, to provide helicopter services and associated personnel and equipment for the pilot Fire and Rescue Helicopter Program, in an amount not to exceed \$367,620 from the Pilot Helicopter Program Fund 10264 contingent on the City Auditor and Comptroller certifying the availability of funds from SAFE and the County for the pilot program, and under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 296841-3

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is further authorized to investigate the extension of the pilot Fire and Rescue Helicopter Program; to seek, accept, and expend additional funds therefor; and to amend or modify any agreements in connection therewith which the City Manager shall deem necessary from time to time in order to carry out the purposes and intent of the pilot program.
