## RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 296896 ADOPTED ON JUL 3 0 2002

WHEREAS, Section 8330 et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code provides a procedure for the summary vacation of public street easements by City Council resolution where the easement is no longer required; and

WHEREAS, the affected property owner has requested the vacation of a portion of San Fernando Street to facilitate development of the site; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the vacation, the City will reserve a general utility and access easement over a portion of the area that will be vacated; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that:

- (a) there is no present or prospective use for the public street easement, either for the public street system for which the right-of-way was originally acquired, or for any other public use of a like nature that can be anticipated in that the right-of-way is not needed for public street, bikeway, or open space purposes;
  - (b) the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land;
- (c) the vacation is not inconsistent with the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; and
- (d) the public street system for which the right-of-way was originally acquired will not be detrimentally affected by this vacation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the portion of San Fernando Street, reserving out a general utility and access

easement, as more particularly described in the legal description marked as Exhibit "A" and as

shown on Drawing No. 19605-B marked as Exhibit "B", which exhibits are attached hereto and

made a part hereof, is ordered vacated.

2. That this resolution shall not become effective unless and until the following

conditions have been met:

a. The applicant shall assure, by permit and bond, the installation of permanent public

improvements at the "L" shaped intersection of Qualtrough Street and San Fernando Street as

follows: Type G-2 curb and gutter on the west side of San Fernando Street, Type G-2 curb and

gutter across the southerly terminus of San Fernando Street (running in an east-west direction),

the installation of Schedule "J" pavement for unimproved portions of the "L" shaped intersection

and a drainage inlet box to convey the intersection drainage discharging via a rip-rap dissipator

on private property, all in a manner satisfactory to the City Engineer.

3. That the City Clerk shall cause a certified copy of this resolution with exhibits, attested

by him under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.


