

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 296899

ADOPTED ON JUL 30 2002

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2002, the Planning Commission of the City of San Diego held a public hearing for the purpose of considering the amendments to the Sorrento Hills Community Plan including associated amendments to the Progress Guide and General Plan; and

WHEREAS, Torrey Views, LLC, requested an amendment to the Progress Guide and General Plan and the Sorrento Hills Community Plan to redesignate the site located east of and adjacent to I-5 and north of Carmel Mountain Road, from RM-2-5 (Multi-Family Residential) to IL-2-1 (Industrial) which is legally described as Lots 1 and 2 of Section 31, Township 14 South, Range 3 West, San Bernardino Meridian, City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California; and

WHEREAS, City Council Policy 600-7 provides that public hearings to consider revisions to the Progress Guide and General Plan for the City of San Diego may be scheduled concurrently with public hearings on proposed community plans in order to retain consistency between said plans and the Planning Commission has held such concurrent public hearings; and



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council adopts an amendment to the Progress Guide and General Plan for the City of San Diego to incorporate the above amended plan.
