WHEREAS, Mr. D'Antuono joined Parson Constructors, Inc., the construction arm of The Parson Corporation, in 1975 as a labor advisor on the massive Alaska Pipeline program and was appointed the President of Parson in April, 1994; and

WHEREAS, as President, he has been instrumental in establishing innovative approaches to labor/management relations and has negotiated and administered ground breaking Project Labor Agreements for major infrastructure and government programs throughout the country; and

WHEREAS, locally, the San Diego County Water Authority Emergency Storage Project is under construction with a project labor agreement negotiated and administered by Mr. D'Antuono and his staff; and

WHEREAS, Mr. D'Antuono is on the Board of Directors of the North American Contractors Association (NACA) and serves on numerous labor/management committees across the nation; and

WHEREAS, he is also a trustee for the Laborers International Union Laborers-Employers Cooperation and Education Trust and a Southern California Regional Board Member of the American Cancer Society (ACS); and

WHEREAS, Mr. D'Antuono exemplifies the high values, standards, and principles of the work of the late John S. Lyons in community service, and it is appropriate at this time that his efforts be acknowledged; NOW, THEREFORE,
