WHEREAS, David has worked as Civil Rights Consultant and Senior Deputy Labor Commissioner for the State of California, Chief of Staff to State Assemblyman Chacon, and as Legislative Consultant to former Assembly Speaker Willie Brown; and

WHEREAS, in 1996, he was hired as Vice President and Chief of Operations for the Parent Institute for Quality Education for the State of California (PIQE) and in 1999, he became President and CEO of PIQE's 10 offices throughout the State; and

WHEREAS, as a community volunteer, David serves as Chair of the Chicano Federation's Board of Directors, Vice Chair of the Board of Directors of Operation Samahan Clinics, member of the National Executive Board of the United Domestic Workers of America, and Co-founder of the San Diego Latino/Latina and Indigenous Unity Coalition; and

WHEREAS, he recently was appointed by Governor Gray Davis to the Advisory Board of the "Reading and Literature Project" in California; NOW, THEREFORE,
