RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 297115 ADOPTED ON SEP 2 4 2002

WHEREAS, the Sewer Pump Station 30A Alternative Project, located near La Jolla Village Drive and the Interstate 5 corridor, in the University City community, will demolish and remove the existing sewer pump station system which is aged and deteriorate and install a new, gravity-fed sewer main. The existing system has no back-up power source to the facility in the event of power outages or disturbances and access to the pump station facility for maintenance purposes is inadequate. The new system will ensure safe and reliable sewer service to the surrounding community and greatly reduce the risk of sewer overflows and spills; and

WHEREAS, on December 10, 2001, the City Council adopted Resolution R-295841, authorizing the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$700,000 from Fund 41505, CIP NO. 46-200.0 for the acquisition of property rights required for the subject project. Property rights were subsequently acquired from three of the five affected owners. Authorization to use the City's power of Eminent Domain to institute condemnation actions for the acquisition of the remaining property rights is now being sought via a separate Resolution of Necessity; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That it is stated for the record that the final Mitigated Negative Declaration for this project, LDR File No. 98-0911, on file in the office of the City Clerk, has been completed in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 (California Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), as amended, and the State guidelines thereto (California Code of

Regulations section 15000 et seq.), that the declaration reflects the independent judgment of the City of San Diego as Lead Agency and that the information contained in the report, together with any comments received during the public review process, has been reviewed and considered by this Council.

2. That the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of Determination [NOD] with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego regarding the above project.
