

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 297125

ADOPTED ON OCT 07 2002

APPROVING MAP OF LA JOLLA CROSSROADS.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Council finds that certain map surveyed by Michael S. Butcher, Licensed Land Surveyor, titled "LA JOLLA CROSSROADS" [MAP], being a subdivision of a portion of the Southeast Quarter of Pueblo Lot 1307 of the Pueblo Lands of San Diego, in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California according to miscellaneous Map No. 36, filed in the office of the County Recorder November 14, 1921; together with Lot 4 of La Jolla Gateway according to the Map thereof No. 11038, filed in the office of the recorder September 14, 1984; together with Parcels A and B of Five Creeks according to the Map thereof No. 12234, filed in the Office of the Recorder October 25, 1988, is made in the manner and form prescribed by law and conforms to the surrounding surveys; that the map and the subdivision of land shown thereon is approved and accepted as shown on the MAP and subject to the conditions as set forth thereon, and the Council accepts on behalf of the public, the following: Judicial Drive, Golden Haven Drive, and a portion of La Jolla Village Drive, and the streets are declared to be public streets, together with all appurtenances thereto, and dedicated to the public use, as dedicated and shown on the MAP.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the slope easement to the City of San Diego recorded December 2, 1970, as File No. 220037, and a portion of the slope easement to the City of San Diego recorded June 25, 1975, as File No. 75-161524, and the building restricted

easements per Map no. 12234 and portions of the sewer easements to the City of San Diego recorded June 11, 1971 as File No. 122364 and recorded July 2, 1971 as File No. 71-143038 and recorded June 25, 1975 as File No. 75-161524 are not shown on this MAP because they have been abandoned pursuant to Section 66434(G) of the Subdivision Map Act.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council accepts on behalf of the City of San Diego, the easements for ingress and egress of emergency vehicles for access to the properties designated as "Emergency Access Easement Granted Hereon," as granted and shown on the MAP and subject to the conditions set forth on the MAP.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council accepts on behalf of the City of San Diego, the easement with the right of ingress and egress for the construction and maintenance of sewer, water, drainage and electrical facilities designated as "Sewer Easement Granted Hereon," "Drainage Easement Granted Hereon," "Sewer and Drainage Easement Granted Hereon," "Electrical Easement Granted Hereon," and "Water Easement Granted Hereon," as granted and shown on the MAP and subject to the conditions set forth on the MAP.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is authorized and directed to endorse upon the MAP, as and for the act of the Council, and that the Council has approved the MAP on behalf of the public as stated in this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to transmit the MAP to the County Recorder of the County of San Diego, California, for recordation.
