WHEREAS, in 1989 People for Trees was created to promote public involvement and support in urban forest ecosystem development; and

WHEREAS, People for Trees was the first urban forestry program established in San Diego; and

WHEREAS, People for Trees has had several members that have contributed immensely to the organization; and

WHEREAS, Laura Li Mandri is one such member who has devoted countless hours to the organization; and

WHEREAS, Laura has advocated for sensitive land use planning, tree enhancement projects in business district corridors, and an increase in the tree canopy of school and park sites; and

WHEREAS, Laura has been integrally involved with the Mayor's Tree Advisory Board and Mayor Murphy's "Tree Initiative;" and

WHEREAS, as President, Laura created an action plan which included merging the duties of executive director and board president into an unpaid position for three years; and

WHEREAS, under Laura's leadership, People for Trees was expanded to address the use of trees for phytoremediation of contaminated sites, creating biotic value-enhancing aesthetics in public and privately owned property, maintenance of the trees planted, and developing a multi-cultural training and education program for urban forestry disciplines; and

WHEREAS, during Laura's tenure as President of the Board of Directors for People for Trees, over 35,000 trees have been planted throughout the greater San Diego area; and

WHEREAS, People for Trees reached a milestone when Laura announced the award of \$10,000 Proposition 12 Grant, and a \$50,000 "Can You Dig It Grant" from the California Department of Forestry, Region Energy Office Grant, in excess of \$100,000, and \$75,000 in CDBG Funds from various Council District Offices and County Supervisor Offices; and

WHEREAS, Laura's leadership and tireless commitment to People for Trees has resulted in great gains with the development of the City's urban canopy; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, hereby proclaims October 12, 2002 to be "Laura Li Mandri Day" in the City of San Diego.
