A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOR GRANT FUNDING OFFERED THROUGH THEIR EMERGENCY HOUSING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the State of California, Department of Housing and Community

Development, Division of Community Affairs, issued a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA)

for the Emergency Housing and Assistance Program (EHAP) (Round #EHAP-X); and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is a nonprofit or local government agency which is eligible and wishes to apply for and receive an EHAP grant; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the City Manager or his designee, the Deputy Director of Community Services, is hereby authorized to apply for an EHAP grant in an amount not more than the maximum amount permitted by the NOFA, and in accordance with the program statute, Regulations, and local Emergency Shelter Strategy, where applicable.
- 2. If the grant applications authorized by this Resolution are approved, the City of San Diego, hereby agrees to use the EHAP funds for eligible activities in the manner presented in the application as approved by the Department and in accordance with the program statute

(Health and Safety Code section 50800-50806.5) and Regulations (Title 25, Division 1, Chapter 7, Subchapter 12, Sections 7950 through 7976 of the California Code of Regulations), and Chapter 117, Statutes of 2002, and the Standard Agreement.

- 3. If the grant applications authorized by this Resolution are approved, the City Manager or his designee, the Deputy Director of Community Services, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute the Standard Agreement, and all documents, including applications, contracts, agreements, and all subsequent amendments with the Department necessary to implement and carry out the purpose of this grant.
- 4. If the grant applications authorized by this Resolution are approved, the City Manager or his designee, the Deputy Director of Community Services, is hereby authorized to accept and expend funds from the Department of Housing and Community Development, Division of Community Affairs, Emergency Housing and Assistance Program (EHAP) (Round #EHAP-X); to implement and carry out the purpose of this grant.
