ADOPTED ON OCT 29 2002

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF THE CENTRE CITY PROJECT AREA COMMITTEE FOR ONE YEAR.

WHEREAS, California Community Redevelopment Law allows the Project Area Committee to function for a three-year period after the adoption of the Redevelopment Plan, and for one-year extensions thereafter by approval of the Council of the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the Centre City Community Plan was adopted in 1992; and

WHEREAS, the Project Area Committee continues to be a valuable community advisory board to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego, and as such has been extended each year since its initial three-year term; and

WHEREAS, the City Council unanimously approved changes to the apportionment of East Village and Little Italy PAC seats on September 10, 2002; and

WHEREAS, changes to the apportionment of seats requires changes to two amendments to the Procedures for Formation of PAC; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Centre City Project Area Committee is extended for one year from November 2002 to November 2003.
