AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE 3,
DIVISION 1, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY
AMENDING SECTION 63.0102 RELATING TO THE USE OF
PUBLIC PARKS AND BEACHES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 6, Article 3, Division 1, of the San Diego Municipal Code is
hereby amended by amending Section 63.0102, to read as follows:

§63.0102 Use of Public Parks and Beaches Regulated

(a) [No change.]

(b) It is unlawful for any person within any public park or plaza or public beach
or beach areas within the City of San Diego to do any of the acts enumerated in
Section 63.0102(b).

(1) through (23) [No changes.]


(24) Large Groups. Except as otherwise required or permitted by
Chapter 2, Article 2, Division 40 of this Code, it is unlawful for any group
consisting of seventy-five or more persons to hold, conduct or participate in any
celebration, parade, service, picnic, exercise, or other special event in any park,
plaza, or beach without having first obtained a permit from the City Manager.

(25) through (28) [No changes.]

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its final passage.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
