

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 19210 (NEW SERIES)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AMENDING THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 6, DIVISION 0, BY AMENDING SECTION 26.30(d) AND BY ADDING NEW SECTION 26.30(g), ALL RELATING TO MISSION BAY PARK COMMITTEE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1: That Chapter 2, Article 6, Division 0, of the San Diego Municipal Code is amended by amending Section 26.30(d), to read as follows:

§26.30 Park and Recreation Board

- (d) The Chair, with the advice of the Board, shall appoint standing and ad hoc committees concerned with specific problems or areas of interest to the Board. The committees shall be composed of Board members, augmented by other representative citizens appointed by the Board Chair. The Board Chair shall appoint board members as Chair and Vice-Chair of each such committee.

Section 2: That Chapter 2, Article 6, Division 0, of the San Diego Municipal Code is amended by adding Section 26.30(g), to read as follows:

(g) There is hereby established a Mission Bay Park Committee to serve in an advisory capacity to the Park and Recreation Board, Mayor, City Council, and City Manager on policy issues relating to the acquisition, development, maintenance, and operation of Mission Bay Park. The Mission Bay Park Committee shall consist of fifteen members, who shall serve without compensation. The members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council, subject to the following conditions:

1. The Mayor shall appoint one member from among the members of the Park and Recreation Board who shall be Chair;
2. The Mayor shall appoint two at large members;
3. The Mayor shall either appoint four members from at least five nominees provided by the Councilmember who represents all of Mission Bay Park, or if two Council Districts include a portion of Mission Bay Park, each Councilmember who represents Mission Bay Park shall each have three nominations of which two from each Councilmember shall be appointed by the Mayor;
4. The Mayor shall appoint one Mission Bay lessee who shall represent a hotel in the Park;
5. The Mayor shall appoint one Mission Bay lessee who shall represent a lessee in the Park other than a hotel;

6. The Mayor shall appoint one Mission Bay Park stakeholder, who shall be a member of an association which uses the recreational waters or parkland of Mission Bay Park;
7. The Mayor shall appoint one member of a non-profit environmental organization;
8. The following planning groups officially recognized by the City pursuant to Council Policy 600-24 shall nominate one member to be appointed by the Mayor as follows:
 - A. One member from the planning group representing the Clairemont Mesa neighborhood;
 - B. One member from the planning group representing the Mission Beach neighborhood;
 - C. One member from the planning group representing the Ocean Beach neighborhood;
 - D. One member from the planning group representing the Pacific Beach neighborhood;


The members shall serve two year staggered terms for a maximum of eight consecutive years. An interval of four years must pass before a person who has served eight consecutive years can be reappointed. Each member shall serve until his or her successor is duly appointed and qualified. The members shall be appointed in such a manner that the terms of not more than eight members shall expire in any year. The expiration date for all

terms is March 1. During March of each year the Committee shall select from among its members a Vice Chairperson. Meetings of the Mission Bay Park Committee shall be held at least six times a year with no two consecutive months passing without a regularly scheduled meeting of the Committee. The Committee shall adopt rules consistent with the law for the government of its business and procedures.

Section 3: That a full reading of this Ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final passage, since a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its final passage.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
