AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SAN DIEGO ORDINANCE NO. O-18766 (FEB. 22, 2000) SETTING ASIDE AND DEDICATING CITY-OWNED LAND, KNOWN AS "MID-CITY ATHLETIC AREA" IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, FOR A PUBLIC PARK.

WHEREAS, the City-owned land, described as Mid-City Athletic Area and designated for public park use, was set aside and dedicated in perpetuity for park and recreation purposes by City Council action on February 22, 2000 (San Diego Ordinance No. O-18766) [Ordinance No. O-18766]; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has the powers, rights and privileges to enact, amend, or enforce any ordinance in respect to municipal affairs as it deems appropriate; and

WHEREAS, the legal description attached to Ordinance No. O-18766 was in error, in that it included certain parcels not intended to be dedicated; and

WHEREAS, a California registered land surveyor has reviewed and approved the parcel maps and legal descriptions incorporated herein as Exhibits A and B respectively as accurate; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Charter section 55 [Charter] provides that all real property owned in fee by the City that is dedicated by ordinance for park and recreation purposes shall not be used for any but park and recreation purposes without a changed use or purpose being authorized by a two-thirds vote of the people; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Charter and Council Policy 700-17, the Park and Recreation Board [Board] has identified the "Mid-City Athletic Area," illustrated in Exhibit C, and recommends that this park be dedicated by ordinance; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-18766 is amended by deleting the legal description originally attached as Exhibit A and by substituting Exhibits A, B, and C, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. That the City Council reaffirms the dedication of the Mid-City Athletic Area as described in Exhibits A, B, and C, and that such land is set aside and dedicated in perpetuity for park and recreational purposes, and that the name of the Mid-City Athletic Area is renamed to Sunshine Berardini Field.

Section 3. That the City Clerk is authorized and directed to file for record in the office of the San Diego County Recorder a certified copy of this ordinance.


Section 4. That a firll reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its final passage.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.


