AN ORDINANCE EXEMPTING A PROGRAM MANAGER POSITION FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE FOR CITY ATTORNEY'S OFFICE

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2003, the Civil Service Commission reviewed a request of City Attorney Casey Gwinn to exempt a Program Manager position from the classified service; and

WHEREAS, this position will be responsible for overseeing a new interdepartmental program for families affected by domestic violence; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission has reviewed the justification for the position and has commented favorably thereon in its memo to the Mayor and Council dated August 18, 2003; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably by the Civil Service Commission on August 7, 2003 as meeting the Charter criterion for exemption from the classified service, and after having considered and reviewed the report thereon from the Civil Service Commission to the Mayor and Council dated August 18, 2003, attached hereto as Attachment A, the position of Program Manager be and is hereby exempted from the classified service and declared to be in the unclassified service of the City of San Diego.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its final passage.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
