ADOPTED ON JAN 28 2003

WHEREAS, the California Arts Council [CAC] has offered the City of San Diego a grant in the amount of \$98,280 to support the San Diego Arts Education Partnership [Partnership]; which is a collaborative effort of the City of San Diego Commission for Arts and Culture [Commission] and the San Diego Unified School District [District]; and,

WHEREAS, the Partnership is responsible for ensuring that a comprehensive education in the arts is offered to every student in the District through the development of a new curriculum, teaching training programs, and experiential learning opportunities provided by local arts and culture organizations; and,


WHEREAS, funds from the grant will be used for administrative oversight, marketing, public relations, and coordinating needs; and,

WHEREAS, acceptance of the CAC grant does not require matching funds; NOW  
THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego that the City Manager is authorized and directed to accept and administer the CAC grant in the amount of \$98,280 for the purposes described above and to implement related activities in partnership with the District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to  
expend the CAC grant in the amount of \$98,280 for the purposes described above.
