\$647.55 to be split \$431.70 to Mr. Guerrero and \$215.85 to Mr. Al-Attia. Mr. Guerrero was a Principle Engineering Aide (Category III) and Mr.

Al-Attia was an Associate Civil Engineer (Category II) at the time of submittal. Mr. Guerrero suggested using 4 inch diameter by 8 inch length cylinder molds for concrete sampling instead of 6 inch diameter by 12 inch as the 4 by 8 are smaller and lighter. Cost savings include cheaper cost per

case, fewer dumpster rentals and increased safety. Mr. Al-Attia was instrumental for the implementation that required in depth research and training necessary for the transition by others and to maintain customer's level of confidence as well as to minimize impacts from an industry

perspective. This suggestion was adopted in June 10, 2002. This is the first half of the award and is considered an operational improvement. The

estimated first year savings are \$4,317.00.
