WHEREAS, at the conclusion of 2002, Jack and Gloria Fishkin retired from their positions with the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, on January 19, 2003, Jack and Gloria Fishkin are to be honored at a retirement dinner celebration at a private home in Cherokee Point; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council does hereby recognize the combined 50 years of outstanding public service given by Jack and Gloria Fishkin to the residents of San Diego.
