A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE MITIGATED NEGATIVE  
DECLARATION FOR UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICTS  
AND ADOPTING THE MITIGATION MONITORING AND  
REPORTING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego considered the issues discussed in Mitigated Negative Declaration LDR File No. 42-0642; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that it is hereby certified that Mitigated Negative Declaration LDR File No. 42-0642, on file in the office of the City Clerk, has been completed in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 (California Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), as amended, and the State guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations section 15000 et seq.); that the Mitigated Negative Declaration reflects the independent judgment of The City of San Diego as Lead Agency; and that the information contained in the Mitigated Negative Declaration, together with any comments received during the public review process, has been reviewed and considered by this Council in connection with the formation of the following underground utility districts:

- Hill Street (Catalina Boulevard to Sunset Cliffs Boulevard);
- Pacifica Drive (Bluffside Avenue to Amity Street);
- Euclid Avenue (Trinidad to Manzanares);
- Princess Street/Spindrift Street (Torrey Pines Road to Paseo Dorado);
- Bird Rock Avenue (La Jolla Boulevard to the end of Bird Rock Avenue);
- Hotel Circle South (Phase I) (Taylor Street to Bachman Place);


- Roswell, 51st (Market Street to Kelton Road, past School); and,
- Camino Del Rio South (Texas Street to Mission Center Road).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council finds that project revisions now mitigate potentially significant effects on the environment previously identified in the Initial Study and therefore, that said Mitigated Negative Declaration, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk and incorporated by reference, is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to California Public Resources Code section 21081.6, the Council hereby adopts the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program, or alterations to implement the changes to the project as required by the Council in order to mitigate or avoid significant effects on the environment, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.
