

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 297765

ADOPTED ON MAR 24 2003

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Attorney desires to continue to undertake the project designated Elder Abuse and Same Sex Domestic Violence Program to be funded in part from funds made available through the Violence Against Women Vertical Prosecution Program administered by the Office of Criminal Justice Planning (hereafter referred to as OCJP); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Attorney of the City of San Diego is authorized, on its behalf to submit the proposals to OCJP and is authorized to sign and approve on behalf of the City Council the Proposal and Grant Award Agreement, including any extensions or amendments thereof, as more particularly described in the Agreement, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 297765.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City agrees to provide all matching funds required for said project (including any amendment thereof) under the Program and the funding terms and conditions of OCJP and that the cash match will be appropriated as required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any liability arising out of the performance of this Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and OCJP disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be in effect for a three-year period beginning July 1, 2002 and ending June 30, 2003.
