

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 297778

ADOPTED ON MAR 25 2003

WHEREAS, the California Department of Health has issued a mandate that all concrete sewer mains currently in service be replaced. To meet that mandate, the City of San Diego has in place a sewer main replacement program. As part of that program, the Sewer Group 619 Project, which affects an area from the east end of Lomas Pass Street, west to West California Street, will replace and rehabilitate approximately 9,800 linear feet of old concrete sewer mains, including laterals and manholes in the Mission Hills and Middle Town Communities within the Uptown Community Planning Area; and

WHEREAS, authorization for the expenditure of funds for costs of the project (Fund No. 41506, CIP No. 44-001.0, Sewer Main Annual Allocation), and authorization to use the City's power of Eminent Domain to institute condemnation actions for the acquisition of the remaining property rights required for the replacement/rehabilitation of the old concrete sewer mains for this project, is concurrently being sought via a separate Resolution of Necessity; NOW

THEREFORE


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That it is stated for the record that the final Mitigated Negative Declaration for this project, LDR File No. 99-0303, on file in the office of the City Clerk, has been completed in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 (California Public Resources

Code section 21000 et seq.), as amended, and the State guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations section 15000 et seq.), that the declaration reflects the independent judgment of the City of San Diego as Lead Agency and that the information contained in the report, together with any comments received during the public review process, has been reviewed and considered by the City Council prior to approving the project.

2. That the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of Determination [NOD] with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego regarding the above project.
