A RESOLUTION MODIFYING THE LIST OF
UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICTS IN THE 2003
CALENDAR YEAR ANNUAL ALLOCATION AND DELETING
COUNCIL POLICY 800-02

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Auditor/Comptroller is hereby authorized to modify the Annual Allocation-Undergrounding of Utilities, San Diego Gas & Electric Company allocation for 2003 Calendar Year as follows:

1. Remove the project known as Gilman Drive from Via Alicante to Frontage Road, estimated at \$766,080, and replace it with Hidden Valley Road / via Capri from Torrey Pines Road to La Jolla Scenic Drive at a cost of \$1,304,790.
2. Remove the project known as 24th Street from Market to K Street, estimated at \$788,000, and replace it with 252 Corridor Park from 38th Street to end of Park at a cost of \$520,000.
3. Remove the project known as Euclid Avenue from Elm Street to Fir Street, estimated at \$76,000, and replace it with Euclid Avenue from Trinidad Way to Manzanares Way at a cost of \$249,800.
4. Remove the project known as Euclid Avenue from Federal Boulevard to Norfolk Terrace, estimated at \$2,327,500, and replace it with 61st Street, distribution only from Imperial Avenue to Division Street, at a cost of \$1,260,000, and Jamacha Road from Meadowbrook Drive to Cardiff Street at a cost of \$945,000.


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5. Remove the project known as Bayside Lane from Belmont Park to Monterey Court, estimated at \$546,500, and replace it with Abbott Street from West Point Loma Boulevard to Newport Avenue at a cost of \$573,000.

6. Remove the projects known as Genter Street from Fay Avenue to Girard Avenue and Girard Avenue from Genter Street to la Jolla Elementary School, estimated at \$210,900 and replace it with Spindrift Drive from Princess Street to Paseo Dorado at a cost of \$210,740.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to remove City Council Policy 800-02 "Undergrounding Program - Use of Case 8209 Funds for Conversion Work on Private Property" from the Council Policy manual.
